#### PORTFOLIO OBJECTIVE

The objective of the portfolio is to seek, through a combination of capital growth and income, returns above the IA Flexible Investment Sector (although the investment constraints of this sector do not apply). By adopting an investment policy using a wide range of assets and actively avoiding areas which could be deemed overvalued, a significant strength of the portfolio is the range of opportunities in which it can invest. The portfolio aims to provide equity like returns but with risk characteristics in line with the IBOSS philosophy. Namely, strong risk adjusted returns for a given level of risk. This means that the portfolio remains a multi asset with a flexible, albeit limited, allocation to both property and bonds.




